

BCX -- The Free BASIC TO C Translator

BCX is a small command line tool that generates "C" source code that targets the free LCC-Win32 compiler.

Download LCC-Win32 from this website: <http://www.cs.virginia.edu/~lcc-win32/>

The BCX setup program creates a single folder for the entire BCX environment. No registry entries are written, no system files are added or modified.

You can uninstall BCX by deleting the BCX folder. In order to produce Windows executable files, you will need to download and install the freely available LCC-Win32 "C" compiler by Jacob Navia.

BCX includes a Windows Help file to show you how to get started. Additionally, the BCX setup program includes over 150 sample BASIC programs for you to learn from. Be sure to explore the CON\_DEMO, GUI\_DEMO, & DLL\_DEMO folders!
